Enjoy a relaxing change of scenery and return home refreshed.

Award Winning Amenities... Reception and Shop

At Perran Springs we provide quality amenities and our park is renowned for a high standard of cleanliness. Our award-winning centrally heated shower block offers free hot water 24hrs a day, private washing cubicles with basin, a coin-operated hairdryer and a make-up area for the ladies. Step into one of our luxury spacious showers, each with its own private, seated area where you can change and keep your clothes dry.

The amenities also include a baby changing room and an outdoor, purpose-built baby potty disposal unit. The launderette contains coin-operated washing machines, dryers and ironing facilities. There is also a freezer for your ice packs.

Our purpose-built elsan chemical disposal point is located separately from all other amenities. The park also has an outdoor wetsuit washing area, ideal for rinsing a sandy suit and board after an active day in the surf.

Our reception tourist information area contains many free leaflets, some with discount vouchers, covering specific local attractions, events and general places of interest within Cornwall. For your reference, we also keep a copy of local telephone directories and a guide to public transport in Cornwall. If you require any further information we will be pleased to help.

Perran Springs also has a licensed shop, which offers bread, milk, essential groceries, beers, wines, spirits, gas exchange sales, camping and touring essentials, and a selection of Cornish food and drink.

To complement our Lakes, the park shop offers a wide variety of coarse rods, reels (inc Shakespeare), line, weights, floats, barbless hooks, disgorgers, pole accessories, landing nets, un-hooking mats, boxes, seats, pellets and flavoured baits. Super Eurotents... Camping Fun Made Easy

Our Super Eurotents await your arrival. Sleeping a maximum of six persons in three bedrooms with built-in ground sheets and zip-up fastenings, raised beds with foam mattresses and a storage area. The kitchen has a two-ring camping gas hob, microwave, full-size electric fridge, electric toaster, kettle and shelving unit, with cutlery, crockery, cooking utensils and pans. The living area has permanent flooring, a table and chairs and an electric light.

Caravan Holiday Homes... A Home from Home

Relax in one of our superbly appointed Caravan Holiday Homes, Our Moorhen Caravan sleeps up to four, and our Mallard, Heron and Kingfisher sleep up to six persons. Your holiday home is situated in spacious tranquil surroundings and is fully fitted for your convenience including a comfortable lounge, seating area and separate bedrooms. They come complete with a lounge gas fire, colour television, Freeview and DVD Player. The kitchens include a full cooker, kettle, fridge and some have a microwave oven. There is ample cupboard space with crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils, pots and pans. Each caravan has a toilet, wash hand basin and shower. Hot water, gas and electricity is included.

Fishing Fun... Here at Perran Springs

Our three privately owned stocked coarse fishing lakes have islands and varying water depths, with features including reeds, wildflowers and water lilies. The Lakes are for the exclusive use of Perran Springs' residents only, by permit, available to purchase from the Reception. Friendly advice is available, if needed.

Anglers of all levels of experience will enjoy catching the variety of fish including carp (common, mirror, leather, crucian and ghost), bream, tench, perch, rudd and roach - all in abundance large and small. The most successful baits are bread, sweetcorn and luncheon meat. See our website for a selection of your own Perran Springs holiday 'Big Catch' photos.

Mayfly Lake was established over twenty years ago, and holds a variety of species including 20lb-plus carp, big tench and big bream. Fishing near the margins is best, either with a pole or rod, using a ledger or float. Best baits are sweetcorn, bread and luncheonmeat.

Butterfly Lake is great for family fishing, with carp up to 15lbs, tench, big perch, rudd, roach and bream. Best method is with a pole using sweetcorn by the islands. Total catches of 50lb-plus are not uncommon.

Dragonfly Lake is recommended for the more experienced and patient carp angler. The majority of carp in this lake are between 10 to 20lbs-plus, with a few bigger ones in-between. Favourite baits include boilies, pop-ups and luncheonmeat. Fish in the deep gullies for best results.

Our fish are kept in good condition and health, due to residents following our fishing lake conditions. These include using a professional knotless landing net, padded un-hooking mat, barbless hooks and disgorgers. Keepnets are not permitted. Please refer to our current park information booklet and website for full fishing conditions.

No Noisy Nightlife... Just Plenty of Wildlife

Our aim is to protect the environment in which we live and to encourage the wildlife which exists and is attracted to our local area. As a holiday park, we are committed to minimising the impact we make on our natural environment. We encourage our guests to join us, to reduce, re-use and take advantage of our recycling area whenever possible.

We actively encourage wildlife to flourish and leave areas throughout the park and some hedgerows to nature. We also manage areas around the lake meadow to promote biodiversity of animal and plantlife, by planting native species where of benefit and carefully maintaining 'wild' areas.

Nature lovers will find Perran Springs a haven for wildlife. Our Lake Meadow provides a natural environment, for a variety of flora and fauna. Most of which, can be spotted from a peaceful walk along the grass pathways of gNat's Nature Trail, or by taking a seat on one of our benches, positioned around our Lake Meadow. Explore gNat's Nature Pond and don't forget to watch for the electric blue dragonflies, shy moorhens and dabbling ducks. You might even be lucky and see our local badger, fox, bats, kingfisher, barn owl and jay.

We also have our own private access to a public footpath which runs through the Carn Moor Nature Reserve and Conservation Area, adjacent to the park. This is an area classified by the Cornwall Wildlife Trust as "an important flowering heathland and wetland", part of the Tywarnhayle Common.

We use water and energy wisely in our facilities, with the introduction of push-button taps, heating water on demand only and motion detected lighting where feasible.

Simple Pleasures... Surrounded by Nature

Our Play Area is great fun for the younger members of the family and the most energetic of children will find plenty of areas in which to run and explore. In our Fox Recreation Meadow there is ample space in which to expel excess energy whilst playing family ball games. Relaxed bicycle riding is allowed in the main area of the park away from the Lake Meadow.

To calm the mind and body, take a quiet leisurely stroll around our Lake Meadow with it's abundance of animals, birds, insects, trees, grasses and wildflowers, stopping for a relaxing break on one of our benches.

Experience Cornwall... from Perran Springs

Visit Perranporth, with its long sandy beach and spend the day sunbathing, surfing under the watchful gaze of the lifeguards, or browsing the shops looking for souvenirs. Venture out on a magnificent coastal walk, then enjoy an evening drink in the nearby local village pub, within level walking distance of our park.

Nearby, in Newquay is the opportunity for many activities; ranging from surfing to golfing, or even deep sea fishing boat trips. Truro, Cornwall's capital city, with it's striking cathedral, and Georgian architecture is the perfect place for some retail therapy.

Discover Cornwall's history and variety, from sleepy secluded coves and villages, to popular holiday resorts with family entertainment. Spectacular beaches and a host of major attractions are all within easy reach, including The Tate Gallery at St Ives and the world famous giant biomes of The Eden Project, just a thirty minute drive away.

Perran Springs... We're Easy to Reach

Travelling westwards through Cornwall, by-pass the village of Indian Queens, remaining on the A30. Continue straight over the roundabout by the wind farm, signed 'Redruth A30' and 'Perranporth B3285'. After 1.5 miles turn right at the Boxheater junction, onto the B3285 signed 'Perranporth' and 'Goonhavern'. Continue along the B3285 for 1.5 miles, following the brown tourism signs marked 'Perran Springs'. The easily accessible park entrance will then be clearly seen on the right hand side.
