The Cornish-born racing car driver and car designer used the outbuildings to carry out development on his cars during his time at Trebah (1961-1971). He removed the WW2 concrete from the beach, built the current boathouse and restored the ponds.

3	Rhododendron "Glory of Penjerrick"	8	Magnolia Campbellii (Giant Pink Tulip Tree)
4	Thujopsis dolabrata (Hiba)	9	Dicksonia antarctica (Woolly Tree Fern)
5	Trachycarpus fortunei (Chusan Palm)	Either the tallest or widest of their type!
