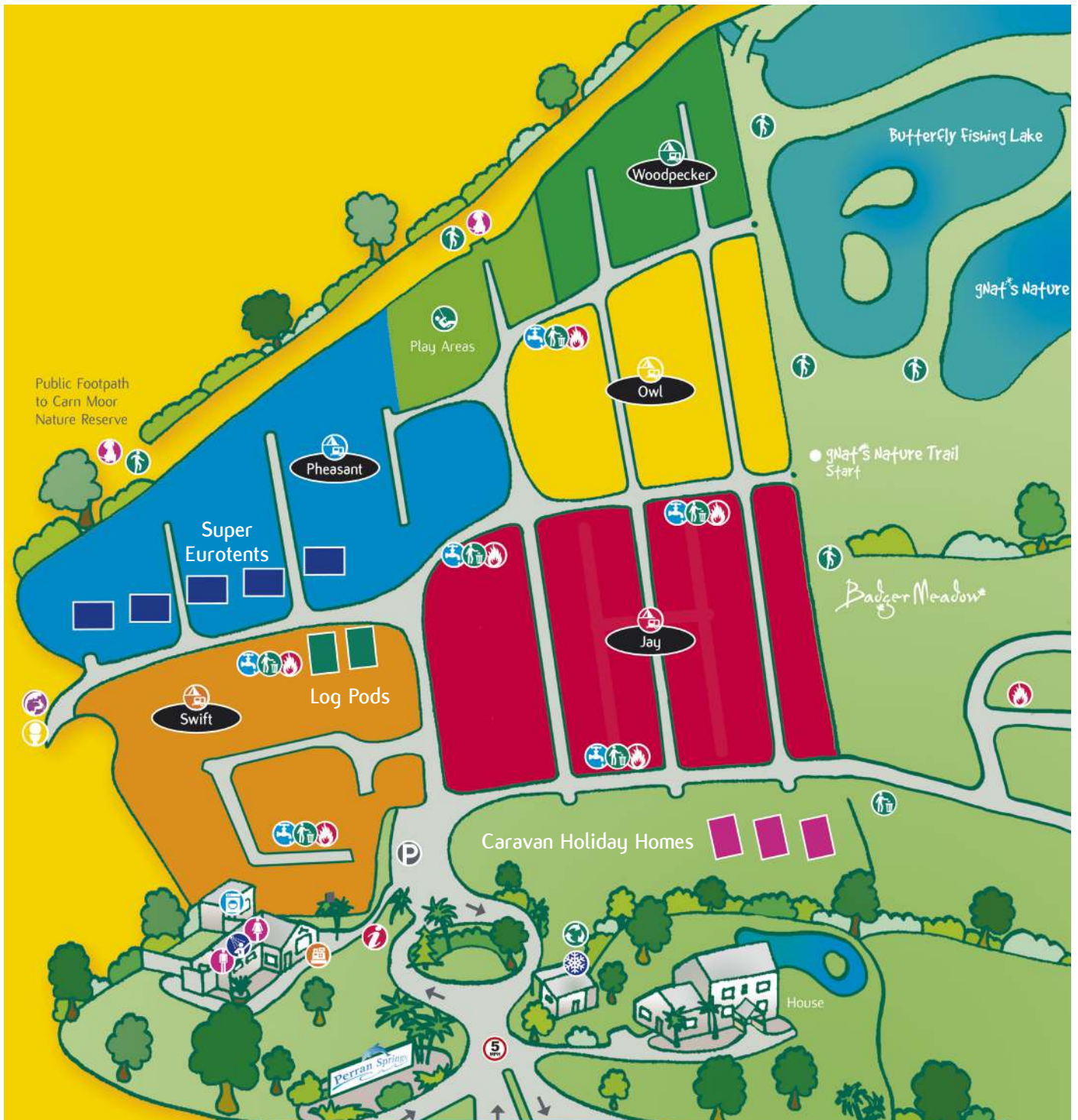




PARK PITCH AREA DESCRIPTIONS AND NUMBER OF PITCHES



Our Pitch Areas

The pitch areas within the park are named after birds, all of which have been spotted at Perran Springs. Although some pitches are closer to the amenity buildings, or play area, or fishing lakes, all pitch areas of Perran Springs are level and easily accessed by a short walk.

Swift Area

This area is always very popular. Most pitches are just a short stroll away from the park's shop and showers. It is ideal if you prefer to be nearer to the amenity buildings. This area also contains our two Log Pods.

The area offers:

6 grass pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

3 are separate, each next to a hardstanding

3 are in a row together

2 grass pitches without electric

these are back-to-back

8 hardstanding pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

2 separate groups of 3 together

2 pitches are also together

2 Log Pods (Heron and Moorhen)

next to one other in a row

Jay Area

This area is central to the park, situated opposite our Caravan Holiday Home area. Some pitches are just a short distance from the park's shop and showers, and some are closer to the Nature Trail entrance. This area is also popular with returning guests who have selected the same pitches year after year.

The area offers:

21 grass pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

most are next to other electric or non-electric grass pitches

2 are also next to a hardstanding

10 grass pitches without electric

all are next to other non-electric or electric grass pitches

4 hardstanding pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

2 separate groups of 2 together

Opposite our Caravan Holiday Homes (Lapwing, Mallard and Cormorant)

next to one other in a row

Pheasant Area

This area is only suitable for tents. It includes some pitches adjacent to our Super Eurotents and also has a small selection of pitches situated near to the play areas, which are very popular with families with younger children. This area is popular with families and couples alike.

The area offers:

16 grass pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

most are next to other electric grass pitches

4 are next to a Super Eurotent

5 Super Eurotents

these are back-to-back

Owl Area

This area is situated between both the Nature Trail and Fishing Lake entrances. This area is particularly popular with returning angling guests and by those who prefer to be just slightly further away from the amenity buildings.

The area offers:

- 12 grass pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

 - most are next to other electric grass pitches

 - 2 are next to a hardstanding

- 4 grass pitches without electric

 - next to one other in a row

- 2 hardstanding pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

 - these are separate to each other, each one is next to an electric grass pitch

Woodpecker Area

This area is one of two closest to the Fishing Lake entrance. Many of these pitches are popular with couples and returning anglers, who prefer to be further away from the amenity buildings. This area also includes a small number of pitches closer to the play area, which are more popular with families.

The area offers:

- 5 grass pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

 - some are next to other electric grass pitches

 - 1 is next to a hardstanding

 - 1 is between an non-electric grass pitch and a hardstanding

- 5 grass pitches without electric

 - 4 are next to one other in a row

- 2 hardstanding pitches each with 16amp electric hook-up point

 - these are separate to each other, each one is next to an electric grass pitch
