

FISHING and our LAKE MEADOW



Our Private Fishing Lakes are strictly for the exclusive use of Perran Springs' paying residents only, fishing is included in your holiday with us. Fishing is strictly between 8am and Dusk ONLY.

Butterfly Lake is great for family fishing, with carp up to 15lbs, tench, big perch, rudd, roach and bream. Best method is with a pole by the islands. Total catches of 50lb-plus are not uncommon.

Mayfly Lake was established over twenty years ago, and holds a variety of species including 20lb-plus carp, big tench and big bream. Fishing near the margins is best, either with a pole or rod, using a ledger or float.

Dragonfly Lake is recommended for the more experienced and patient carp angler. The majority of carp in this lake are between 10 to 20lbs-plus, with a few bigger ones in-between. Fish in the deep gullies for best results.

For safety reasons the Lake Meadow must not be entered or used between Dusk and 8am. NO DAY TICKETS.

By Law you MUST have an Environment Agency Rod Licence in order to fish.

All children must be fully supervised by a competent adult at ALL times - no exceptions.

Do not ingest anything found in the Lake Meadow or Park hedgerows.

The Meadow is a place for quiet fishing, walking or sitting. No running. It is not a play area or place for parties.

No bicycles or any vehicles are allowed.

The bridge may be slippery during/after wet weather.

NO VISITORS are permitted to fish or enter/walk around the Lake Meadow

Dog and Pet Information

To ensure all guests enjoy their holiday, pet owners are asked to follow these points:

Dogs / Pets...

- ... will enjoy being walked around the park pitch areas, Badger Meadow, Recreation Meadow and the Lake Meadow.
- ... to walk your dog on the adjacent public footpath, use the gated access behind the play area.
- ... must wear a collar and identity tag and keep their ADULT owners on a short lead at all times.
- ... must not be left unattended on the park.
- ... are not allowed to swim in the lakes.
- ... are not allowed in the Reception / Tackle Shop, Shower Block, Wi-Fi Room, Facility Buildings, or in our accommodation units.
- ... fouling must be cleared immediately, so 'bag and bin' that poo in the general waste.
